SIGNAGE WORKS - SYDNEY SHOWGROUND HOMEBUSH BAY

Central Signs were engaged by the Olympic Co-ordination Authority in February 1998 to provide signage for the new Sydney Showground at Homebush Bay. The contract works included directional signage and large scale building signage over the 30 Ha site to a value of around \$0.5 Million.

The work was undertaken in the context of urgent completion of the Showground building and landscape works in the lead-up period to the 1998 Royal Easter Show. From the time of award of the contract to completion there was a 7 week period in which to complete and install the works. This was achieved successfully by the Company and to a high standard of finish and installation, a result which was a credit to Central Signs and an essential element in completing the 23 major buildings within the new Showground.

Central Sign's ability to deliver the contract works to time and budget with professional management was of significant importance to the Authority at the closing stages of this large-scale fast track project and assisted towards the conduct of a very successful opening on April 3, 1998.
